OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The tournament will be played in accordance with the approved rules of the game, which are currently used in the casino. The option to "Chop" will not be allowed.
2. Only Casino Nova Scotia gaming equipment will be allowed on the tournament tables during play.
3. Participants will be required to wear a tournament name badge to enter the tournament area and at all times during play. No substitution of players will be allowed.
4. Beverages are permitted in the tournament area.
5. A guest is eliminated from play if they violate tournament rules, in which case they must leave the tournament area. The official tournament language is English.
6. **Any player who has not registered with tournament officials by 10:45 AM on the day of the tournament may be removed from the tournament**
7. Players will be randomly assigned to one of the eight tables..
8. To determine the table and position a player sits during a round, each player will draw a card which shows the table and seat number.
9. All players will be advanced \$5000 of non-value chips. Chips from the previous round will be carried forward.
10. Blinds will increase after every 30 minutes. The management reserves the right to alter limits on the final table. All chips must be kept in sight, stacked by color, and may not be removed from the table.
11. Single knockout event tables will decrease proportionally as players are eliminated. Top 10 scores will advance to the final round. Final round will continue until one player is left.
12. Players advancing from the preliminary round will have their chip totals carried forward.
13. Players absent from the table will have their Blind Bets and antes placed by the dealer.
14. There are unlimited raises per betting round. At any time the player may bet equal to the big blind, higher than the big blind, or go all in.
15. Following the announcement to end the current betting level, the new level begins with the next hand. A hand is deemed to have started once the dealer delivers the first card to the small blind.
16. All players have the right to a hand – even if the chips in their possession are insufficient to place the minimum bet.
17. Decks will only be changed at a scheduled break, not at a level change.
18. There will be no coaching of any kind.
19. No player may miss a blind, with the exception of a player moving into the small blind position, resulting from a table breaking or balancing.
20. When chips of a smaller denomination have become obsolete, all chips will be chipped up to the next higher color chip denomination before the new level commences.
21. At the start of the final table, all players will have their chip totals announced.
22. If two players are eliminated in the same hand, the player with the most chips going in finishes higher.
23. Players' chips must be counted down, verified, and signed for before leaving the tournament table.
24. In the event of a problem during play, it is the responsibility of the player to bring it to the attention of the floor supervisor immediately. All disputes must be resolved prior to players leaving the table.
25. In any dispute, the decision of Casino Nova Scotia is final.
26. Prizewinners are eligible for one prize only. All prizes will be awarded
27. All applicants who are unable to participate may be given a full refund of their entry fee less the administrative fee, providing that they have the receipt of their entry fee, and the refund is given within 6 months of the tournament date.
28. By entering the tournament, each player also grants permission to Casino Nova Scotia to use their names, photographs and prize winnings for promotional purposes without compensation.
29. Tournament continues until a winner is declared.
30. Each player must protect his/her hand at all times. All players must act in turn.
31. No collusion. Each player is obligated to play in his/her own self-interest. Any information about a folded hand given to an active player must be shared with all active players.
32. Verbalizing by any active player stating "call", "fold", "check", "raise", "all in", or a specified size bet will be bound by that statement.
33. Each participant acknowledges that they will play and be bound by the official rules and procedures of the tournament. Bad Beat Jackpot hands are ineligible during tournament play.
34. A player infraction will result in a 30 minute time out. The player will still be responsible for all blinds and antes.
35. A second infraction will result in disqualification.

Terms and Conditions

Subject to the terms and conditions contained herein, this application shall entitle the applicant, upon acceptance, to compete in a Casino Nova Scotia table games tournament. We reserve the right to deny or reject any applicant once accepted for any reason which, in its sole judgment and discretion, it deems proper as authorized by law. The applicant shall abide by all tournament rules as published and amended. We reserve the right to cancel the tournament for any reason on or before March 20th, 2010. If cancelled, all applicants will be promptly notified and all monies paid shall be refunded and neither party shall have further liability to the other. The tournament shall not be open to persons under 19 years of age or to the employees of Casino Nova Scotia/ Great Canadian Gaming Corporation and their subsidiaries, or any other persons prohibited from gaming or prohibited from entering the premises under Nova Scotia law. In consideration of my being allowed to participate in said tournament, I do hereby accept and agree to the foregoing conditions and declare that I am not prohibited from casino gaming or from entering the casino under Nova Scotia law. False information on the official entry form shall be grounds for immediate disqualification and may cause forfeiture of any prize money and merchandise won in the tournament at the sole discretion of Casino Nova Scotia.
